OVERVIEW

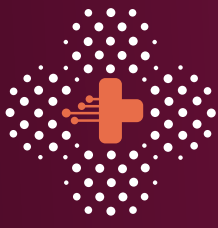

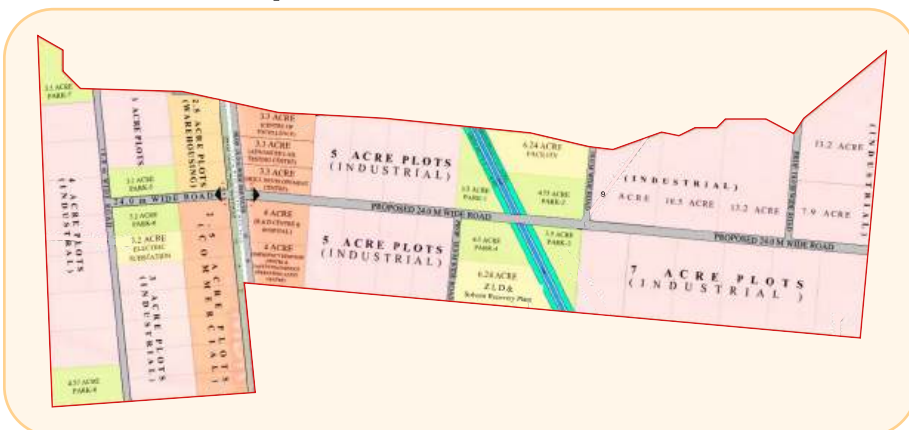
